<p>What did you learn about leadership from completing this field experience? How did this learning relate to the knowledge, skills and dispositions required of an educational leader? How did it enhance your ability to lead?</p> <p>This field experience allowed me to gain leadership by taking on the perspective of a Data Coach.
